

Decorum of Online classes

- → Punctuality is especially important for online learning
- →IThe students are expected to be attentive in class and participate in the class activities.
- → Provide a dedicated place for the child to attend to his/her online classes without any disturbance or any distractions.
- →It is required that the webcam is operational and the student is visible on camera during assessments.

Assignments and Internal Assessments

- * Students will be given class as well as home assignments from time to time for which they may require to use web sources apart from their textbooks.
- * Students should work independently and submit work on time.
- * Grade wise individual folders on Google drive will allow students to upload their assignments, tests and tasks which will also allow students to compile their digital portfolio.
- * As per the new circular by CBSE on Art Integration Every student needs to do one Art Integrated Project per subject. Students are expected to work on a project as assigned by the teacher and integrate any form of Visual or Performing Art in the subject.

- teachers will also be conducting Art/subject Integrated Activities as part of Subject Enrichment Activity and students will be marked on the same.
- → Besides Art Integration Project, students are expected to complete EBSB [Ek Bharat Shreshta Bharat] and WE projects
- The Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat" project was announced by Hon'ble Prime Minister on 31st October, 2015 on the occasion of the 140th birth anniversary of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel. ... This project allows students to explore and experience the cultural diversity of States/UTs while realising that India is one.
- → SEWA [Social Empowerment through Work Education and Action] is a program by CBSE that aims to focus on the mental, emotional and social health of a student.

- → Teachers will conduct multiple assessments during the class. It is expected that students do not miss any formative assessments conducted.
- → The assessments can be in the form of Quizzes, MCQ, One Mark Questions, Case study based questions, student presentations etc. all conducted during the class time.
- → In case a student is not able to appear for any particular assessment due to medical reason, the concerned teacher should be informed prior or on the same day. A medical certificate should be sent to the teacher

Assessment and Evaluation system

- Since the emphasis is more on competency-based learning as opposed to traditional rote learning, the assessments will be devised on higherorder thinking skills of creativity and critical thinking and not merely understanding and knowledge.
- All assessments are designed to suit and facilitate the online teaching learning process.
- Grade X will be appearing for their 1st periodical test from 21st June 2021

Educloud App and updates

- School Circulars are regularly uploaded on educloud app to inform the parents about the school events.

Screen time and online learning

- Consider limiting your children's cell phones and tablets until their schoolwork is done satisfactorily.

- Make sure that your children take plenty of breaks in order to get physical activity and time away from screen.
- As much as possible, parents should encourage print and book reading. Have discussions with your children about what they are doing, and also encourage creative writing.
- Help your ward to prioritize and learn to create goals, tasks, and deadlines, just like adults do when they go to work. Tasks that may not have been difficult for them while attending school in person can become more challenging when learning from home, so it's important to reinforce boundaries and offer incentives at times for healthy behaviors.
